POSITION SUMMARY

AKF USA is seeking a Fundraising Data Analytics Officer to be responsible for performing data analytics, as they relate to optimize fundraising programs and donor engagement in Resource Development (RD) and Planned and Legacy Giving (PLG).

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

CRM Data Analysis

- Retrieve data from AKF USA's CRM system and to analyze historic and current donor data for trends, significant changes with a view to plan and optimize resource development efforts.
- Perform fundraising related data analysis on a regular and ad-hoc basis to glean learnings that drive data-driven decisions on fundraising campaigns.
- Prepare visuals, charts, and presentations for management meetings.
- Ensuring timely completion of reports for the Foundation and associated institutions.

- Create queries and reports from our CRM (EveryAction) and other databases used by AKF USA stakeholders.
- Maintain data cleanliness and ensure policies/processes are followed to keep a clean database.
- Respond to donor and volunteer questions and informational needs and provide training.
- Support fundraising campaigns of the Foundation and other AKDN agencies.
- Work with the RD and PLG team to strategize fundraising activities. Work with fundraising staff and volunteers to prepare, review and disseminate fundraising reports that track campaign progress, quarterly KPIs, and progress towards annual objectives.

Other Functions

- Using various data extraction tools, collect data relating to potential donors from other online databases. Data includes information about donation history, events attended, demographic background, volunteer roles and vocational interests.
- Provide comparative analysis on effectiveness of various giving channels.
- Monitor AKF USA's fundraising effectiveness against other comparable organizations.
- Conduct surveys with focus groups to ascertain specific preferences for various population segments, such as professionals, business leaders, and youth.
- Provide data analytics support to formulate short-, mid-, and long-term plans to determine strategic initiatives that enable planning and implementation of cost-effective fundraising and awareness programs, including those that are held virtually and in-person.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- A bachelor's degree in statistics, data analysis, or IT
- Demonstrated experience in donor and gifts data management.
- Experience in data analytics, surveys and/or modelling tools.
- Experience with CRM tools and MS Excel.
- Excellent interpersonal and communications skills.
- Understanding of MS Office tools, including Access, Word, and proficiency in Excel
- Candidates must be currently eligible for employment in the United States.
